Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 175049

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Jobe Materials, L.P. (Jobe) (CN602822363) has submitted an application for an initial permit number 175049. The Van Horn Quarry Rock Crusher (RN109645754) will product aggregate at 1945 SW Frontage Rd, Van Horn, Culberson County.

This permit will authorize the installation of rock crushers, screens, hoppers, and conveyors use to crush stone and separate the resulting material into various grades of aggregate. Jobe has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (tons per year)
Particulate Matter (PM)	45.7
Particulate Matter less than 10 microns (PM10)	17.5
Particulate Matter less than 2.5 microns (PM2.5)	2.2

The new facilities will be controlled by water sprays to suppress dust emissions and the roads will be controlled via the application of water from water trucks.
