

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 176243

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Shumard Corporation (CN603133927) has submitted an application for initial permit number 176243. The Mineral Wells Facility (RN111639787) will produce/manufacture fiberglass products at 248 Ross Road, Mineral Wells, Palo Pinto County.

This permit will authorize the spraying and hand-laying of resin and gelcoat to produce fiberglass products as well as any required cleaning and refining operations. Shumard Corporation has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new facilities will be controlled by the use of non-atomized mechanical application spray guns, use of hand applied tools, and good cleaning management.
