

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 176255

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Iron Horse Terminals, L.L.C. (CN605890219) has submitted an application for initial permit number 176255. The Terminal Railcar Maintenance and Cleaning Facility (RN110416716) will produce/manufacture railcars at 11800 Highway 90, Beaumont, Jefferson County, Texas 77713.

This permit will authorize new surface coating activities at the existing facility. Iron Horse Terminals, L.L.C. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new facilities will be controlled by good cleanup and storage practices, as well as use of low dusting abrasives and cartridge filters achieving a minimum of 99.9% reduction efficiency.
