Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 176283

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Newpark Drilling Fluids LLC (CN604719187) has submitted an application for initial permit number 176283. The Newpark Snyder Facility (RN106901499) will produce/manufacture drilling fluids at 319 North Lubbok Highway, Snyder, Scurry County.

This permit will authorize the emissions that are generated from mixing/blending of materials for the production of water-based mud products to support the oil and gas drilling activities. Newpark Drilling Fluids has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

PM	<0.01
PM10	0.01
PM2.5	<0.01

The new facilities will be controlled by a dust filter sock that collects particulates. This is a totally enclosed process. Grounds are also periodically sprayed with water.
