Entergy Texas, Inc. (CN603282054) has submitted an application for initial air permit number 177473/N316. The Lone Star Power Station (RN112041959) will produce electricity for sale at 0.5 Miles East of Intersection of U.S. 59 North and Sylvester Road, Cleveland, Liberty County, Texas.

This permit will authorize a natural gas fired simple cycle combustion turbine generator with supporting equipment. Listed below are the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the emission sources associated with the new facility.

NOx emissions from the new combustion turbine will be controlled with selective catalytic reduction and CO and VOC emissions will be controlled with oxidation catalyst.
