

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 177727

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Jr.'s Texas Best, LLC. (CN603988239) has submitted an application for initial permit number 177727. The Junior's Smokehouse Processing Plant (RN111931911) will produce processed meat products at 1603 Divide Street, El Campo, TX, Wharton County.

This permit will authorize use of the large smokehouses for smoking, which is part of meat production. The application requests authorization of five large smokehouses, which will use a thermal oxidizer to control particulate matter from smoke emissions. Jr.'s Texas Best, LLC. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Particulate matter from smoke emissions will be controlled by a thermal oxidizer.
