

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 179199

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Ameri-Fab, LLC (CN604474551) has submitted an application for initial permit number 179199. The Ameri-Fab Facility (RN106991300) will fabricate and coat equipment for the oil and gas industry at 6364 West Interstate 20, Weatherford, Parker County.

This permit will authorize updated surface coating materials, application rates, and metal fabrication activities. *Ameri-Fab, LLC* has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

PM2.5	0.05

The Ameri-Fab facility will be controlled by *high-transfer efficiency airless spray guns, low-VOC coatings, and dry filtration systems for surface coating, while particulate emissions from metal finishing will be controlled using enclosed booths and dust collectors.*
