Tivoli Midstream CB2, LLC (CN606319218) has submitted an application for initial permit number 179343. Chocolate Bayou Terminal (RN112071998) will store various chemicals and serve as a terminal for those chemicals at 6610 FM 2917, Alvin, Brazoria County. This permit will authorize various chemicals for storage and loading. Tivoli Midstream CB2, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
