

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source
Review Permit Number 181189**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Altus Midstream Processing LP (CN605629864) has submitted an application for initial permit number 181189. The Diamond Cryo (RN110059250) will process natural gas and liquids at the site located approximately 2.7 miles north on FM2903 from I-10, Balmorea, Reeves County.

This permit will authorize the Diamond Cryo Facility. Altus Midstream Processing LP has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities will be controlled by multiple flares and regenerative thermal oxidizer combustion control devices and implementation of approved leak detection and repair programs.
