

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 181201

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

TrinityRail Maintenance Services, Inc. (CN603236076) has submitted an application for initial permit number 181201. The Plant 117 (RN100225523) will service railcars needing rubber lining replacement at 1815 S Main St, Vidor, Orange County.

This permit will authorize railcar degassing, surface blasting operations and hand-applied full rubber lining replacements of railcars. TrinityRail Maintenance Services, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new facilities will be controlled by a scrubber for railcar desgassing and a dust collector for surface blasting operations.
