

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 18295**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC (CN600134761) has submitted an application for renewal of an Amendment to Permit Number 18295. The Beaumont Terminal (RN102596210) is a site that receives, stores, and distributes various volatile organic liquids and refined petroleum products at 3900 Highway 366, Nederland, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of volatile organic liquid and refined petroleum product storage tanks, railcar and truck loading and unloading facilities, barge and ship loading and unloading, control devices used to burn vapors emitted from loading operations and associated fugitive components. The amendment will authorize the correction of stored liquid properties, the correction of emission representations, and removal of storage tanks from the permit that were never built. Phillips 66 Pipeline, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by devices that burn the waste vapors from the facilities before the vapors are emitted to the atmosphere. There are no changes in control to the new and/or modified facilities.
