

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Initial Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 183501

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Bell Textron, Inc. (CN600131155) has submitted an application for initial permit number 183501. The MV-75 Advanced Manufacturing Center (RN112345756) will produce/manufacture helicopter rotor blades and gear boxes at 15100 N Beach St, Fort Worth, Tarrant County.

This permit will authorize gear box and rotor assembly and painting operations. Bell Textron, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (tons per year)
VOC and Exempt Solvents	33.27 and 31.89
PM/PM10/PM2.5	0.06/0.06/0.06
Hazardous Air Pollutants	2.17

The new facilities will be controlled by filters to collect dust from painting operations and will use paints with low solvent content to minimize air emissions.
