

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 18553**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Trinity Tank Car Inc. (CN601657091) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 18553. The Plant 19 (RN 100224435) owns/operates an abrasive blasting and surface coating facility for railcars at 140 Shady Brook Lane, Longview, Harrison County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Longview Plant, which includes, but is not limited to, welding, cutting, grinding, abrasive blasting, interior lining, and exterior painting of railcars. Trinity Tank Car, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by paint arrestors and a regenerative thermal oxidizer.
