

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 18756

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

The Praxis Companies, LLC (CN60598404) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 18756. The Ennis Facility (RN102539145) produces/manufactures fiberglass-reinforced bath products (bathtubs) at 1504 South Kaufman Street, Ennis, Ellis County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of storage, coating, and finishing activities related to the manufacturing of fiberglass-reinforced bathtubs. The amendment will authorize a decrease in the amount of HAP emitted from the facility in relation to the bathtub manufacturing coating process and characterize particulate matter emissions related to the plastic coating mixing process. The Praxis Companies, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
