

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 21557**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Groendyke Transport, Inc (CN600350292) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 21557. The Groendyke Channelview facility (RN102331956) is a Tank Semitrailer Cleaning and Maintenance Facility located at 8503 Sheldon Road, Channelview, Harris County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of a wash rack comprised of four (4) covered wash bays, a flare, a natural gas-fired boiler, one (1) diesel storage tank, facilities for wastewater storage and treatment and loading, and associated diesel and wastewater fugitives. Groendyke Transport, Inc has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by the flare during the cleaning process for those chemicals last transported that require control by the flare.
