

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 21999**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

COTAC USA, INC. (CN606076974) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 21999. The Transportation Container Cleaning Facility (RN103052650) conducts tank container maintenance and cleaning at County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the tank container cleaning rack and vapor controls, including a flare and carbon adsorption unit. The amendment will authorize extending the capability for internal container cleaning to two existing adjacent bays previously used for external wash and hydrotesting. COTAC USA, INC. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
