

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 22914

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

BNSF Railway Company (CN600276901) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 22914. The Mark IV Transloading Facility RN102705019 transloads products between tank trucks and railcars at 1500 Northeast Parkway, Fort Worth, Tarrant County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the railcar/tank truck transloading of products. BNSF Railway Company has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.
