

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New
Source Review Permit Number 24618**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC (CNCN600134761) has submitted an application to renew and amend Permit Number 24618. The Lubbock Products Terminal (RN104565056) produces/manufactures bulk fuels at 3102 Clovis Road, Lubbock, Lubbock County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of gasoline, diesel, ethanol, transmix, and fuel additive storage tanks and truck loading operations of products. The amendment will authorize the replacement of two additive tanks with two new additive tanks containing a new fuel additive, and it will authorize a decrease in additive, transmix, and ethanol throughputs. There will be no change to gasoline or diesel throughputs. Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are either controlled by a vapor combustor (truck loading) or vented to the atmosphere (tanks).
