Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 25004

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Phillips 66 Company (CN604065912) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 25004. The San Bernard Terminal (RN100221092) is a marine loading, unloading, and storage facility at intersection of FM 524 & AVE A turn left onto Ave A go 2.1 mile on Ave A CR 372 to San Bernard Terminal, Sweeny, Brazoria County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the San Bernard Terminal, which includes storage tanks, fugitive piping components, marine loading operations, and associated emissions control devices. Phillips 66 Company has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
