

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification Application for  
Air New Source Review Permit Number 26002**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Louisiana Pacific Corporation (CN600127534) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 26002. The Carthage OSB Mill (RN100215433) manufactures Oriented Strandboard at 1199 County Road 201, Carthage, Panola County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of equipment associated with oriented strandboard manufacturing, including debarkers, waferizers, blenders, sawlines, paint booths, hammermills, thermal oil heater, burners, dryers, engines, pressing equipment, material storage, etc. The Louisiana Pacific Corporation has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.
