

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal**  
**Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 26278**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

*Frazier & Frazier Industries, Inc. (CN600279343) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 26278. The Foundry (RN100835446) produces/manufactures Ductile and Gray iron castings at 817 South 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Coolidge, Limestone County.*

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of melting iron to produce Ductile and Gray iron castings through a standard molding practice. *Frazier & Frazier Industries, Inc.* has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

PM10	24.03
PM	10.45
VOC	6.86
NOx	0.35
SO2	0.05
CO	0.07

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by current water scrubbers & bag house equipment for dust collection processes.
