

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 27353

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC (CN603452400) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 27353. The Compressor Station 14 (RN102758018) provides for natural gas transmission at the facility located six miles east of Falfurrias on State Highway 285, Falfurrias, Brooks County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of three glycol regenerator burners, one flare and process piping component fugitives. Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same. The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by a flare.
