

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 3467B**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

LBC Houston, L.P. (CN601179849) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 3467B. The LBC Houston Bayport Terminal (RN101041598) is a contract bulk storage and terminal facility for liquid products at 11666 Port Road, Seabrook, Harris County.

This amendment will authorize construction and operation of 42 new internal floating roof (IFR) storage tanks, 2 new barge loading/unloading docks, and removal of existing 32 vertical fixed roof (VFR) tanks of varying sizes. LBC Houston, L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by the same control methods currently in place. All new storage tanks will operate with an internal floating roof.
