

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 21104**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. Delek Refining, Ltd (CN602831232) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 21104. The Tyler Refinery (RN100222512) produces/manufactures Petroleum Refinery at 1702 Commerce Street, Tyler, Smith County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of Steam Boiler No. 10. Delek Refining, Ltd has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.
