

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 42528

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Univar Solutions USA Inc. (CN600471346) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 42528. The Univar Solutions Odessa Pronto Facility (RN102534708) is a chemical distribution and storage facility at 105 Pronto Avenue, Odessa, Ector County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of chemical storage tanks and loading operations. The amendment will authorize new loading equipment, a new control device, updates to the maximum loading rates for loading activities, and updates to the approved chemical list. Univar Solutions USA Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are not controlled. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by a vapor combustion unit for loading chemical products with a vapor pressure greater than 0.5 psia at 95°F.
