The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Martin Marietta Materials Southwest, LLC (CN606114726) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 43481. The Black Spur Uvalde Plant (RN100215367) will produce/manufacture crushed and processed stone at 4483 Ranch Road 1022, Uvalde, Uvalde County.

This amendment will authorize updated throughput rates for equipment at the Ballast plant in addition to updating stockpile acreage. Martin Marietta Materials Southwest LLC has listed in its application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
