

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 44726**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

The Pittsburgh Paints Co. (CN600268437) has submitted an application for and amendment to permit number 44726. The PPG Architectural Finishes facility (RN101645307) will produce/manufacture adhesives at 3410 Lucius McCelvey Drive, Temple, Bell County.

This amendment will authorize the facility to use materials according to updated product formulations. No new equipment is set to be constructed and no changes to the existing equipment are being requested. The Pittsburgh Paints Co. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
