Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 100927

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Eagle Ford Pipeline LLC (CN6044094508) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 100927. The Corpus Christi Dock (RN106337937) is a marine loading facility located on Suntide Road 0.1 miles South of Carbon Plant Road, Corpus Christi, Nueces County.

This renewal will authorize the continued marine loading of crude oil and condensate. Eagle Ford Pipeline LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by the burning off of vapors which lowers emissions going into the air for marine loading operations and by a fixed roof with filling by submerged pipe which provides entry below the liquid surface to minimize splash and vapor formation for storage tanks less than 25 thousand gallons in capacity.
