

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 49131

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

ExxonMobil Corporation (CN600920748) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 49131. The Colonial Storage Facility (RN102553336) is a Bulk Storage Station and Terminal for finished petroleum products at 14713 West Port Arthur Road, Beaumont, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the bulk storage station and terminal consisting of eleven storage tanks and ancillary equipment. ExxonMobil has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by work practice and equipment standards such as floating roofs and fugitive piping component emission monitoring via audio, visual, and olfactory (AVO) checks.
