Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 50542

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Enterprise Refined Products Company LLC (CN603684408) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 50542. The North Houston Terminal (RN102596376) stores gasoline, transmix, diesel, jet fuel, and ethanol and loads out gasoline, transmix, diesel, and jet fuel at the North Houston Terminal, located at 17724 East Hardy Road, Houston, Harris County.

This renewal *will authorize the continued operation of storage vessels, truck loading racks, and additives handling facilities.* The amendment will authorize *updates to the product throughput and sulfur dioxide emissions from the vapor combustor. Enterprise Refined Products Company LLC* has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by *a vapor combustor*. The new and/or modified facilities will be controlled by *the existing vapor combustor*.
