

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 52862

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Dr. George B. Hill (CN 601491715) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 52862. The site location name, Your Paws to Remember, (RN102941267) produces/manufactures the incineration of domestic animal carcasses. The applicant provided the following driving directions: from the Floresville city limits traveling north on U.S. 181 North, drive 2.25 mile to County Road 331, turn right on County Road 331, drive approximately 1.1 miles down until you reach Oakhill RV/Trailer Park privacy gate on the left, enter thru gates and drive .15-mile past mobile homes and enter GM Ranch through the locked gate, drive .15 miles to crematory, Floresville, Texas 78114, Wilson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of this facility. This facility is solely used for the cremation of deceased domestic pets (animals), a service that has been requested by the owner of the deceased pet (animal) for the purpose of cremating their pet instead of burying their pet or having to dispose of their pet's remains. The bodies of the deceased pets (animals) are prepared off-site and then transported in sealed cadaver bags. No one other than the transporter has access to the remains being transported. Once arriving at the facility, the transporter will place the deceased pet (animal) in the incinerator for cremation. Dr. George B. Hill has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.

The facility being renewed continues to be controlled by an incinerator with an added after burner which sends any produced emissions in the main compartment to then pass through an after burner which re burns the exhaust to eliminate any odors or smoke produced. This unit meets/exceeds EPA guidelines for emissions.
