

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 53610

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Veolia WTS USA, Inc., (CN600286553) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to Permit Number 53610. The Veolia Beaumont Plant (RN102601994) produces/manufactures chemicals and chemical preparations at 10658 Highway 90, Beaumont, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of chemical manufacturing processes, liquid storage tanks, loading operations, and associated utilities. The amendment will authorize a change in service or an increase in throughput for certain storage tanks. Veolia WTS USA, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
