

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number [53849]**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application. [Sunoco Pipeline L.P] (CN[602373904]) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number [53849]. The [Hebert Station] (RN[100715762]) produces/manufactures/operates a pipeline breakout station at [15645 W Port Arthur Road], [Port Arthur], [Jefferson] County. This renewal will authorize the continued operation of [bulk storage tanks and associated fugitives and ancillary storage tanks. The facility receives, stores, and distributes gasoline and diesel.]. [Sunoco Pipeline L.P.] has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.*
