

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 56473

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company (CN600616049) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 56473. The Goodyear Tire and Rubber Beaumont Chemical Plant (RN102561925) produces/manufactures synthetic rubber at 11357 IH-10, Beaumont, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of pollution reduction equipment controlling emissions associated with maintenance, startup, and shutdown (MSS) activities at the plant units. The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total maximum potential amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Carbon Monoxide (CO)	647
Nitrogen Oxides (NOx)	432
Organic Compounds (VOC)	152
Sulfur Dioxide (SO ₂)	27
Particulate Matter with diameters of <10 microns	60
Particulate Matter with diameters of <2.5 microns	0.01

The MSS activities continue to be controlled by steam boilers and flares for which the permit is renewed.
