

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 56516**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Pabtex, Inc. (CN603731837) has submitted an application for Renewal of Permit Number 56516. The Pabtex Terminal (RN102194768) performs marine cargo handling and storage of pet coke at 209 Taft Extension, Port Arthur, Jefferson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the marine cargo handling and storage facility. Pabtex, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

PM	46.46
PM10	22.01
PM2.5	3.33

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by opacity/visible emissions monitoring, operational limits, and dust suppression.
