

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 56523**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and is not a federally enforceable representation of the permit application.*

Lhoist North America of Texas, LLC (CN605752088) has submitted an application for renewal of Permit Number 56523. The Nolanville Mine (RN100834902) produces Crushed Stone in Bell County at 11714 FM 439, Nolanville, TX 76559.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of this area's crushing, screening, drying, and loading of stone material. Lhoist North America of Texas, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant proposed to be emitted annually for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by wet suppression and best management practices.
