

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 6113**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

San Antonio Refinery, LLC (TSAR) (CN604256628) has submitted an application for an amendment to Permit No. 6113. The San Antonio Refinery (RN101485183) will produce/manufacture refined petroleum at 7811 S. Presa Street, San Antonio, Bexar County.

This amendment will authorize additional throughputs for storage tanks and loading operations, new emission caps for storage tanks, and update emission calculations for storage tanks and loading control devices. TSAR has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Vapors from truck and rail loading are burned off via flare and vapor combustor, which reduces emissions into the air.
