

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 6141A**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

The Union Carbide Corporation (CN601688781) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 6141A. The No. 2 Low Pressure Polyethylene Plant (LPP2) (RN102181526) will produce/manufacture polyethylene, catalyst precursor material, and catalyst at UCC Seadrift Operations, Seadrift, Calhoun County.

This amendment will authorize changes to NSR 6141A to increase the supplemental fuel which can be sent to the site's Small Flare (EPN 705). This increase is necessary to meet regulatory requirements involving upcoming MON MACT heating value requirements for the flare. The Union Carbide Corporation has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for the facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for the facility.

The modified facilities will be controlled by a flare.
