

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number [71574]

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

[Croell, Inc.] (CN[605948314]) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number [71574]. The [Perryton Redi-Mix Plant] (RN[104216148]) produces/manufactures [Ready-Mixed Concrete] at [1201 NE 8th Ave.], [Perryton], [Ochiltree] County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of [ready-mixed concrete using aggregate constituents of variable size, water, and cement/flyash in small quantity depending on customer concrete specifications]. The amendment will authorize [the use of equipment to satisfy a wider range of customer specific products in a timely manner to satisfy variable customer demand]. [Croell, Inc.] has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
