

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 72762

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Plains Pipeline, L.P., (CN601440852) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 72762. The Basin Tank Farm (RN100214824) is a crude oil storage facility at 1301 S. County Road 1150, Midland, Midland County.

This renewal and amendment will authorize the continued operation of crude oil storage tanks and associated piping components. Plains Pipeline, L.P. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by external floating roof tanks with primary and secondary seals. There are no new modified facilities.
