The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Delek Marketing – Big Sandy, LLC (CN604084517) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 7431A. The Mount Pleasant Products Terminal (RN101969020) is a bulk liquid storage terminal at 1503 W Ferguson Rd, Mount Pleasant, Titus County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the liquid storage tank farm and truck loading terminal. The amendment will authorize updates and corrections to emission calculations for storage tanks and loading operations. Delek Marketing – Big Sandy, LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
