The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Crown Cork & Seal USA, Inc, (CN602717332) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 75271. The facility located in Conroe, TX (RN10071118) produces/manufactures aluminum beverage cans at 2501 N. Frazier ST, Conroe, Montgomery County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of Crown Cork & Seal's Conroe, TX facility for the manufacturing of aluminum beverage cans. Crown Cork & Seal has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Pollutant	Proposed Emissions (tons per year)
VOC (volatile organic compounds)	144.13 tons per year
HAPs (hazardous air pollutants)	Less than 25 tons per year

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by a regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) air pollution control device.
