

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 83193**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

IACX Rock Creek LLC (CN605745843) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit number 83193. The Sneed Booster Station (RN100220052) processes natural gas at Skelly School Road, Dumas, Moore County.

This amendment will authorize an increase in the amount of gas from the sulfur recovery unit that is routed to the flare (FLR1) during incinerator (TGI) downtimes. IACX Rock Creek LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
