

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 88

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Enterprise Refined Products Company LLC (CN603684408) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 88. The Baytown Terminal (RN100219591) offers a "for hire" storage and transfer terminal at 4225 Decker Drive, Baytown, Harris County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of tanks, engines, sumps, and piping fugitives. Enterprise Refined Products Company LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed will continue to minimize emissions through the use of specialized tanks and good management practices.
