

Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Certification Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 932

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Luminant Generation Company LLC (CN603256413) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 932. The Martin Lake Steam Electric Station (RN102583093) produces electricity at 8850 FM 2658 N, Tatum, Rusk County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of coal handling activities. Luminant Generation Company LLC has certified there will be no changes to the permit. The following permitted emission rates will remain the same.

Coal handling emissions continue to be controlled by water and surfactant sprays, enclosures, rotoclones, and compaction. Emissions during maintenance, startup, and shutdown continue to be limited in duration and subject to work practice standards in permit number 933.
