The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Eagle Railcar Services, LP. (CN601733538) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 9345A. The Eagle Railcar Services facility (RN102955150) coats and cleans railcars at 404 Highway 287 S, Elkhart, Anderson County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of equipment associated with maintenance of railcars, including railcar cleaning stations, abrasive blasting stations, coating booths, etc. There are no new or modified facilities associated with permit renewal. Eagle Railcar Services, LP has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The paint booths contain air filters to reduce particulates, and the railcar cleaning is controlled by the flare, which will lower the emissions that are going into the air.
