Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 942A

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

NuStar Logistics, L.P., (CN603180662) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 942A. The San Antonio East Terminal (RN102071131) produces/manufactures petroleum refined products at 4719 Corner Parkway #2, San Antonio, Texas 78219, Bexar County.

This renewal and amendment will improve operational flexibility for all floating roof tanks, authorize the storage of gasoline with a higher vapor pressure, standardize the material characterization of diesel fuel, update the calculation methodology for all tanks to the latest emission factors, consolidate all floating roof tanks into a single cap, remove two additive tanks, remove benzene speciation throughout the permit, and incorporate applicable PBRs and SPs.. NuStar Logistics, L.P., has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by vapor combustion unit (VCU) for VOC control which burns off gasses lowering what goes into the air.
