

## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 94791

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Univar Solutions USA Inc. (CN600471346) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 94791. The Houston FM 529 Facility (RN102341880) is a blending, storage, repackaging, and distribution facility. at 11235 FM 529 Rd, Houston, Harris County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Univar Houston 529 Facility. The only updates include storage tank calculation methodologies. As a result of the change in TCEQ calculation methodology requirements, a small increase in emission allowable will occur. This is not a result of a change in operation. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be updated, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed that are required to be controlled will continue to be controlled by the regenerative thermal oxidizer.
