

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 95**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

INEOS USA LLC (CN602817884) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 95. The Chocolate Bayou Plant (RN100238708) produces/manufactures a variety of chemicals at the site located 2 miles south of the intersection of FM 2917 and FM 2004, Alvin, Brazoria County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the No. 1 and No. 2 Olefin Units. INEOS USA LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by implementing good operating practices, proper equipment design (e.g. floating roofs on storage tanks), combustion devices such as flares, and implementation of TCEQ monitoring programs.
