

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal and Amendment  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 9560**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

INV Nylon Chemicals Americas LLC (CN605811850) has submitted an application for renewal of and an amendment to permit number 9560. The Victoria Site (RN102663671) produces various chemicals at 2695 Old Bloomington Rd N, Victoria, Victoria County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Cogen Unit and the update to calculation methodology for an existing source. The amendment will authorize the consolidation of Permit by Rule Registration No. 119719. INV Nylon Chemicals Americas LLC has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities being renewed are controlled by SCR, flare, and a carbon adsorption system to minimize emissions to the atmosphere.
